

Avonair Curling Club “Chase the Ace” 2022/23 General Information and Rules

1. A full version of the Raffle Rules will be posted in the Avonair at all times and copies will be available to anyone who wishes to read them.
2. All tickets will be sold for \$5.00.
3. 4000 total tickets will be available for purchase throughout the course of the raffle.
4. No one under the age of 18 is permitted to buy or sell a raffle ticket.
5. Tickets can be purchased in the Avonair Curling Club Lounge or Office.
6. Tickets must be purchased using cash or cheque (made payable to the Avonair Curling Club).
7. Each week, 50% of the funds collected will be allocated to the Avonair Curling Club, 30% of the funds will be allocated to the progressive jackpot, and 20% of the funds will be allocated to the week's winning ticket holder.
8. Each week on Monday, at approximately 4:00 pm, a ticket from the prior week's sales will be drawn in either the Avonair Curling Club Lounge or Lobby. The winner will receive both 20% of the funds from that week of sales and the opportunity to draw a card from a standard deck of 52 cards - seeking the Ace of Spades.
 - a. If the Ace of Spades is drawn, the ticket holder will win the progressive jackpot.
 - b. If the Ace of Spades is not drawn, the progressive jackpot will roll over to the draw the next week.
9. Anyone who will not be present at the draw will be asked to write their full name and contact information on the back of the ticket so that they can be easily contacted if drawn. A list of draw dates and times is provided along with these rules.
10. Photo identification matching the name on the ticket is required for all winners claiming cash prizes.
- 11. The winner will have until 3:00 pm the day following the draw (approximately 22-23 hours) to arrange to choose their own card from the deck. The winner will have seven days from the date of the draw to claim their cash prize.**
12. A card can be drawn from the deck in one of four ways:
 - a. The winner can come to the Avonair in person to choose their card. Staff will be available on Mondays from 4:00 pm - 8:00 pm and on Tuesday from 11:00 am - 3:00 pm.
 - b. The winner can choose a proxy to come to the club and draw the card for them. To do this, the winner must contact the club and provide the name

of their proxy and their consent for them to draw the card for them. **The proxy has no claim to the prize.** If the Ace of Spades is drawn, the prize will be held for the winning ticket holder to claim.

- c. The winner can video chat with the club and choose their card over the camera.
 - d. The winner can phone the Avonair and name a staff member as their proxy to choose the card for them.
13. If the winner is unable to collect their card within the allotted amount of time, they will forfeit their chance to choose their own card. A member of the Avonair staff - with at least one other person present to observe - will shuffle the deck, place it face down on a flat surface and choose the top card off of the deck. This card will serve as the winner's card choice.
14. If the winner does not collect their cash prize within the allotted seven days, they will forfeit the cash prize and it will be added to the progressive pot.
15. If contact information is not provided on the ticket, the ticket number will be posted on the website, social media, and the office window in an effort to let the winner know. If they do not contact the club within the allotted above timeframe(s), they will forfeit their right to choose a card and will forfeit their cash prize. All cards will remain in the deck and the cash prize will be added to the progressive jackpot.
- a. If no contact information is provided on a ticket stub, the winner will be required to surrender the matching ticket stub - along with photo identification - to claim their prize. No prize will be awarded without a matching ticket stub.
16. A running list of winning tickets will be kept in the office window and on the Avonair Curling Club website. The names of weekly winners will not be posted anywhere without permission.
17. If all 4000 tickets are sold before the end of the season - or before the Ace of Spades has been drawn - the raffle must immediately stop. In this case, the winner of the progressive jackpot will be chosen from the final pool of ticket holders. The winner will not be required to choose a card, as the raffle will have come to an end.
18. If the season ends and the Ace of Spades has yet to be drawn, the final draw date will be April 3, 2023. All tickets sold during the week of March 28th - April 2nd will be included in the final draw for the jackpot. The winner will not be required to choose a card, as the raffle will have come to an end.
