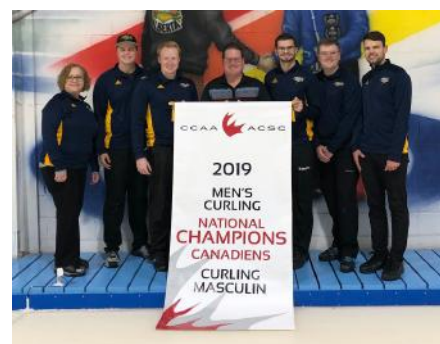
The winner of the Qualifier will play in the Curling Alberta Club Provincial Championships April 1-5 held at the Avonair Curling Club.
